Chris Impey, Professor and Deputy Head of the Astronomy Department at the University of Arizona made this revealing statement on page 12 of the May 2010 *Astronomy* magazine:

“It’s a bit of an embarrassment not to understand 95 percent of the universe.”

Those who do not live with a reverential “fear of the Lord” are really lost in a sea of knowledge—no matter

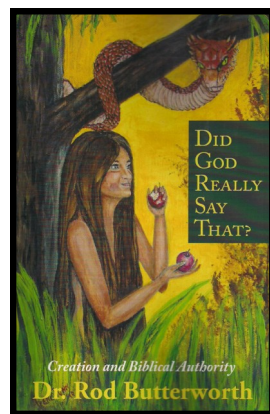
how exhaustive—that does not prepare them for the after life of eternal existence.

"Wisdom and knowledge will be the stability of your times, and the strength of salvation; The fear of the LORD is His treasure" (Isaiah 33:6).

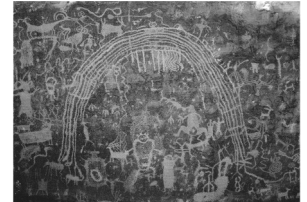
